Lá Fhéile Pádraig: The feast of our national patron, St Patrick will be celebrated on Monday 17th March. It is a Holy Day of obligation and we will have Mass on Monday in St Benedict's Church, Coolmeen at 9.45am, in St Michael's Church, Kildysart at 11am and in St Mary's Church, Cranny at 6.45pm.

The theme of this year's Trócaire Lenten campaign is 'Let Justice flow like a river' (Amos 5:24); and the focus is on 'Water'. In many African countries 51% of people do not have access to clean water. The Trócaire box and poster features Enestina, a nine year old girl from Malawi. Until Trócaire worked with her community to develop a borehole. Enestina had to carry 15 litres of water twice a day a distance of 1 KM for her family. During the dry season the queue to get water can take hours. As a result she frequently missed school or arrived there feeling tired. Trócaire boxes will be available in our Church next weekend. You are welcome to take one for your home and/or place of work and use it during Lent. The people of Coolmeen-Cranny have been extremely generous in the past in support of the work of Trócaire.
